Foot Surgery on August 4th

I underwent surgery on my right foot to correct some problems relating to osteoarthritis on August 4th. During the outpatient surgery two bones were fused, and a metal plate and part of a cadaver bone were installed. I am not to put any weight bearing on that foot for three months and can't drive. So Diane is wearing two more hats right now, chauffeur & nurse.

Then, to show how loving, caring and merciful our blessed Savior Jesus is, I had been given some strong pain medication to begin taking. However, to be able to do ministry I need to have a clear mind. Additionally, I have worked with individuals who took these medications after surgery and quickly became addicted. Therefore, the day after surgery I stopped the medication and asked Jesus to take the pain away. That was a month ago now and I have had absolutely no pain to this date. Why do we doubt Him and His desire to bless us.

The surgery was on Friday and I took Monday and Tuesday off before resuming counseling duties. In our last newsletter I reported that we had scheduled 137 sessions in May & June. In the last two months we scheduled 130, so we have not allowed the surgery to adversely effect the work at the Center.

Thanks to all our prayer partners who prayed for a successful surgical outcome.

In July & August we scheduled 130 appointments with individuals in 13 states (SD, VA, WA, MO, NJ,

OK, MN, FL, TX, GA, AL, MS, PA). International counseling sessions were completed in Budapest, Hungary. Additionally, we have received a counseling request from Dubai in the United Arab Emirates.
